"M" indicates multi-mark, i.e. two responses for a question or an incomplete erasure;

- "." indicates missing, i.e. 1) the question was not asked,
- 2) the question was not answered, or
- 3) the pencil mark is too light.

"Inv/NoRsp" on the following report means the response was invalid-a "6", multimark ("M"), or missing (".")

Explanation of the t test: On the following pages, you see the average of the scores given by your students on each of the items as well as the corresponding average based upon all the other courses campus-wide using the same item. Also, a t-test has been computed on the difference between the average for your course and the average for the other courses using the item. Generally speaking, when probability is listed as lower than 0.05, one would conclude that less than 5 times out of 100 one would claim no difference between the two averages, or the difference of the two is not likely to be due to random chance. In other words, a population represented by your class and a population of the other classes seem to have a non-random difference. Neither the reported t value nor its associated probability should be considered as the sole basis for an evaluation of your instructional efficacy. Other factors (classroom conditions, scheduling, etc.) may have contributed to the non-random difference.

If your report includes statistics on Your Course, this means the statistics for all the instructors teaching the same course, either multiple instructors or multiple sections.

On the scale from 1 to 5, the C points to the Campus average, the Y represents Your class.
